

emanuel tres wines

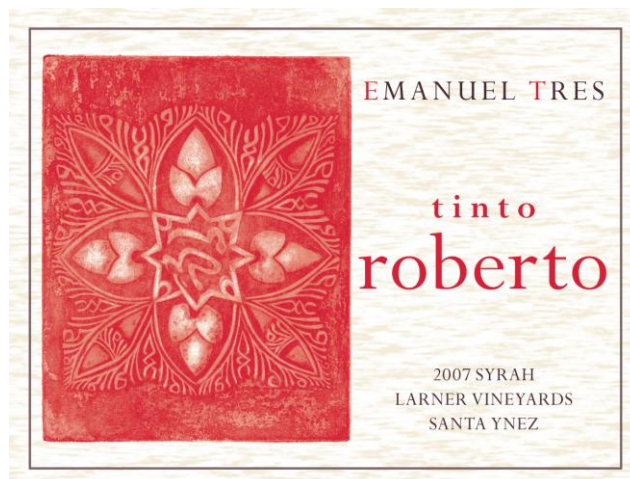

2007 Tinto Roberto

The 2007 Tinto Roberto from Larner Vineyards is a perfect display of the character of an Hermitage clone of syrah planted in the Santa Ynez Valley.

2007 was a terrific year for the production of wines made to age for the long haul. High acidity and low yields created wines of both finess and power with great concentration, yet elegant aromas and depth on the palate.

Fermented in open top containers, then finished in 15% new French oak, the wonderful fruit grown at Larner Vineyards by Michael and Christine Larner takes center stage in an elegant wine built for grilled meats and cheese.
